

How to... add your peace story (of any format) directly to the peace map

Let's say your peace story won't work on the blog (maybe it's a video or sound recording) or has multiple locations. You can add items directly to the peace map using the form here. Simply fill in the form and click submit. Your story will pop up on the peace map. Here's the form: <https://fastfor.ms/220EF>.

Multimedia: Do you want to add a video, podcast, timeline or other multimedia item to map? In the description box, describe what your contribution is. E.g. A video interview with a descendant of xxx. The website box should include the link directly to the video

Peace trail, relevant historical location: In the description box, describe the place and what someone might find if they visit. In the website link box, include a link to more information about the place, be it on Visit Wales or Wikipedia.

Multiple locations: Fill in the form several times copy and pasting the information but changing the location.

How do I find out latitude and longitude? On Google Maps, right click on the story location and click on 'what's here?' Copy and paste the numbers (they look like this 51.490642, -3.201756). The first number is latitude and the second is longitude. This locates your pin on the peace map.
